ACTION TAKEN

On Thursday, July 19, 2024 at approximately 1509 hours, I was dispatched to Garner Correctional Institute located at 50 Nunnawauk Rd in the Town of Newtown, for the report of deceased male inmate.

Upon my arrival, I was met by the scene supervisor, SGT Dalling. Prior to our arrival, I was met by Captain Major who stated Johnson's body was transported to a separate area of the prison prior to our arrival (AP room #205).

SGT Dalling, TPR Stella and myself conducted a survey of the cell, which appeared to be relatively disorganized due the emergency medical response and the manner of death. Upon arriving to Gulf unit, cell G102 was closed. The exterior of cell G102 was manned by a posted GCI Corrections Officer in front of the

door. Once in the cell, I observed a white colored bed sheet on top of the top bunk with multiple books, papers, snacks and prisoner paperwork scattered in the area. There were no signs of any criminal activity.

I then met with Captain Gordlis and Captain Wright to review paperwork and video footage of the scene/area. I then reviewed CCTV footage of unit Gulf and cell #102 but due to the camera angles, it did not show the area of Johnson's cell. I then reviewed video footage of the hand held video of "Code White" (medical emergency) involving Johnson. The hand held video captures GI staff members and EMS workers performing lifesaving maneuverers on Johnson, then transport him to AP room #205. Captain Wright then stated that throughout the course of attempting to resuscitate Johnson, he was given Narcan a total of five (5) times.

Captain Wright's GI Incident Brief report, stated in summary that upon entering the cell he observed Johnson laying on the floor and to be unresponsive. A AED machine was utilized and Johnson was then transported from Gulf Unit to AP room #205. Throughout the escort of Johnson, staff continued life-saving measures. At approximately 1405 hours, Newtown Ambulance arrived at GI. Paramedic Ryan Horn and the Newtown Nuvance Health Paramedic Emergency Medical Services continued CPR. At approximately 1431 hours, Paramedic Horn called Danbury Hospital's ER Dr. Lingus who authorized the presumption of death at 1433 hours. (SEE ATTACHED)

Brian A.Snider (LPN) stated in his GI Medical Report report that immediately after CPR was initiated, half of a white medication fell from the top bunk onto the floor. The medication was expected to be the drug Vraylar, in which Johnson does not have a prescription for. (SEE ATTACHED)

I then received the incident report written by GI Correctional Officer Bello. Bello stated in his report in summary the following:

I was assigned to Gulf Unit #2 on the 8x4 day shift. At approximately 1:57 hours, while conducting a routine tour of the unit I observed inmate Johnson in who appeared to be in medical distresses on his top bunk. I then repeatedly tried to communicate with Johnson but he did not answer. I then called a Code White (medical emergency) and called for the unit nurse to respond via radio. Staff then responded and begun lifesaving maneuvers while they put Johnson in a mechanical wrist restraint. Johnson was then put on a mega mover and transported out of the unit to AP room #205 via stretcher. It should be noted that at approximately 1:30pm and 1:45pm, I conducted my tours and I observed Johnson to be actively on his tablet. (SEE ATTACHED)

SGT Dalling, TPR Stella, ME Investigator Jack DeOliveria and I then arrived in the room (AP room #205) that Johnson's body was transported to prior to arrival. I observed Johnson's body to be in a white body bag zipped up. I then did an inspection of Johnson's body and located a "Inmate Request Form" folded up in his right shirt pocket. Johnson in wrote in summary on the form that he believed that he was having a allergic reaction to the medication "Methadone". Johnson then wrote that his feet were getting swollen after taking the medication. The note did not appear to be officially signed off on by a medical professional. (SEE ATTACHED)

It should be noted that troopers attempted to speak with Johnsons cell mate who declined to speak.

I then requested and reviewed the 24-Hour CCTV video footage leading up to Johnson's death. Due to the camera angles, the video footage did not show Johnson's cell. The video was seized into evidence.

TPR. Stella then photographed the scene utilizing her digital camera, Canon Elph 150. TPR. Stella then burned those photographs to (2) CD's and labeled each. (Refer to TPR. Stella's' supplemental report)

(1) one Item was found within Gulf block cell 102 along with (2) two items released from GCI staff and were seized as evidence by TPR Stella. (Refer to TPR Stella's' supplemental report)

BODY FOUND:

Johnson was located by Garner CI CO Bello. Johnson was observed to be in medical distress on the top bunk in the Gulf unit cell 102.
