On Sunday, July 21, 2024 at approximately 1019 Hours, I was dispatched by Troop A desk personnel to a reported untimely death at Garner Correctional institute located at 50 Nunnawauk Road Newtown, CT 06470.

Sergeant Krynski #178 and I arrived shortly after and were escorted to Garner CI's Lieutenant's Office. There we spoke with Captain Gordils. He informed me that Inmate Tyler Cole (DOB-4/12/1992 Inmate-#385184) had been found unresponsive in his cell. Cole was in Cell-#217 in Gulf-Unit. A "CODE WHITE" (Medical Emergency) had been called at approximately 0918 Hours.

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Emergency services responded to the scene, attempted life saving measures and Cole was pronounced at 1003 Hours. Paramedic Monetta contacted Danbury ER and Doctor Glen Blondstrum pronounced Cole.

I spoke to all the correctional officers that observed Cole over the past 24-hours. The officers that were assigned in the unit that conducted their routine checks.

Correctional Officer Garrie Levy provided a written statement and is summarized in the following. CO Levy stated he was working in Cole's unit on 7/20/24 from 0800-1600 Hours. He stated that he was tasked along with the other officers to make a tour every 15 minutes of the cells, which they did. He did not recall Cole exiting his cell during his shift. He stated he did check to make sure that his chest was rising and he was actively breathing throughout his shift. He remained in the same position which is not uncommon in this unit due to the medications the inmates are on according CO Levy. Due to scheduling conflicts I obtained a verbal statement from CO David Nelson. He confirmed the same statement as CO Levy. He stated the cells were checked every fifteen minutes from 0815-1545 Hours by him and CO Levy.

Correctional Officer Chelsea Fann provided a written statement and is summarized in the following. CO Fann stated she was working with CO Allen in Cole's unit. She stated she was tasked to check the cells every fifteen minutes to ensure that the inmates are alive and well. She stated they checks are conducted randomly amongst the two CO's, but are conducted every fifteen minutes. She does not recall Cole exiting his cell during her shift. She did checked and observed his chest rising and that Cole was actively breathing. She stated she shined her flashlight and was certain that Cole had moved and was alive. She stated Cole never requested any medical assistance or relay any issues to her. At approximately 2315-2330 Hours, she conducted her last tour and relayed no issues to the midnight shift.

Correctional Officer Qunita Allen provided Sergeant Krynski a written statement and is summarized in the following. CO Allen worked on 7/20/2024 from 1600-2400 Hours and was assigned to Cole's unit. CO Allen states tours were conducted every fifteen minutes throughout the entire shift except when they came out of the cell for chow at approximately 1700 Hours. She stated was able to confirm that Cole was alive throughout her shift. Cole spent a majority of her shift lying on his bunk, but she did not notice anything suspicious or out of the ordinary.

Correctional Officer Melvin Triplett provided Trooper Cole #739 a written statement and is summarized in the following. CO Triplett worked the midnight shift on 7/21/2024 from 0000-0800 Hours in Cole's unit. CO Triplett stated he was tasked to check the cells every fifteen minutes, which he did. He stated he was unfamiliar with the inmates in this unit because it is not his normal unit. He did not recall if Cole exited his cell while breakfast was served. CO Triplett stated he shined his

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flashlight in the cell door window to observe the inmates sleeping throughout the night. He made sure that all inmates chests were rising and actively breathing. At approximately 0745 Hours, CO Triplett conducted his last tour. He stated he was not relayed anything and did not have anything to relay to the next shift.

CO Levy also worked day shift on 7/21/2024 from 0800-1600 Hours. He stated that there were no issues reported from the midnight shift. He stated he started his tours at approximately 0800 Hours and did not observe anything wrong with Cole. CO Levy stated he was assigned to the control panel at 0900 Hours. He stated he started popping doors open so the inmates could receive their methadone. CO Levy reported that Cole's cell mate, Malek Spears, came to him and reported that Cole was unresponsive and had not woken up from last night. CO Levy stated CO Nelson immediately responded to the cell and called for medical staff. A "Code White" was called due to Cole being unresponsive. CO Levy stated medical staff responded, performed CPR and administered NARCAN. Cole was taken from the cell on a stretcher while staff was still working on him.

Correctional Officer Thomas Nelson provided a written statement and is summarized in the following. CO T. Nelson stated he worked the day shift on 7/21/2024 from 0800-1600 Hours. He stated third shift did not report any issues to him. He stated he conducted his cell checks every fifteen minutes from 0800 Hours to the last one at 0915 Hours. He stated it appeared that Cole was sleeping. CO T. Nelson stated at approximately 0916 Hours, Cole's cell mate, Spears, came to staff to report that Cole had been sleeping in the same position since dinner the night before. CO T. Nelson stated he responded to the cell immediately to check on Cole. He stated he called Cole's name out but he was unresponsive. He stated he instructed Spears to exit the cell. CO T. Nelson tapped Cole's foot, but he was still unresponsive. He then called for a nurse and the nurse called for a "Code White." Medical staff then responded and began performing CPR and administered NARCAN. Cole was removed from the cell on a stretcher while staff continued CPR.

Cole's cellmate, Malik Spears, did not wish to speak with me and/or report anything regarding this incident.

24-Hour Background

I spoke with all correctional officers that worked in the past 24-Hour period. They all reported the same observations. They stated they conducted their checks every fifteen minutes. They stated that it appeared that Cole was sleeping, breathing and not in any form of distress.

I requested and received the video footage of the Gulf-Unit over the last 72-Hour period. This DVD was tagged as evidence. Our major crime unit was assigned to review this footage to ensure there was nothing suspicious.

I was also provided with (2) copies of the footage of the portable camera that captured staff actively performing life saving measures on a Cole. This was conducted in his cell and on the stretcher leaving the cell.

Medical Examiner's Report:

Sergeant Krynski contacted the Office of the Chief Medical Examiner and completed a Medical Examiner Records Request, requesting all medical records on Cole. This request was filed under ME-#24-14240.

CASE STATUS:

The case is currently under investigation. Cole's death is unknown at this time, but this will be confirmed by the OCME report when provided.

Due to being unfamiliar with the inmates of Gulf-Unit, I was unsure if inmate Cole stepped out of his cell while breakfast was being served. While conducting my checks, I would shine my flashlight into the cell door window to observe the inmates sleeping. I did not observe anything unusual or out of the ordinary during the course of my shift. I checked to make sure that all inmates chests were rising and actively breathing during the course of my shift. At approximately 07:45 AM, I conducted my last tour for my shift. Evening-shift did not relay any issues with Cole and we did not report any issues to the Day-shift. I have no additional details to add regarding this incident or any other inmates.

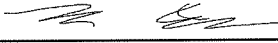

On 7/21/2024, I was assigned to work first shift (8:00 AM-4:00 PM) at Garner CI and was assigned to the "Gulf-Unit." I was working with CO Levy in this unit. Third-shift did not report any issues or anything out of the ordinary regarding Inmate Tyler Cole. We are tasked to check the cells every fifteen (15) minutes to ensure that the inmates are alive and well. We randomly conduct the checks between us, but one of us does it every fifteen minutes. When I conducted my tours from the start of my shift, I did not observe anything wrong with Cole. It appeared that he was sleeping. At approximately 09:15 AM, I conducted my last tour of Cole's cell and he appeared to be sleeping. At approximately 09:16 AM, Inmate Malek Spears, came down to the desk to report that his cell mate, Cole, has been sleeping in the same position since dinner the day before. I immediately responded to the cell to check on Cole. I called Cole's name out and he was unresponsive. Spears also called out Cole's name and he remained unresponsive. I then instructed Spears to step out of the cell. I tapped Cole's foot to see if he would respond, but he did not. I requested that CO Kondash get the nurse. The nurse then came up to the cell and yelled for someone to call a "Code White." Medical staff then responded and began performing CPR and administered NARC AN. Cole was removed from the cell on a stretcher while staff continued CPR. I have nothing else to report regarding Cole's well being.

At no point during my shift did Cole report any issues to the first-shift.

On 7/21/2024 I worked the same shift as 7/20/2024 in the same unit. Third shift reported no issues or anything regarding Cole. I started my tours at 08:00 AM and did not observe anything wrong with Cole. At 09:00 AM I was assigned to the control panel for the doors to the cells. I was starting to pop the doors open, so the inmates could receive their methadone. Cole's cellmate, Inmate Malek Spears, came to us and reported that Cole wasn't responding and had not woken up from last night. CO Nelson immediately responded to the cell and called for medical staff. A "Code White" was called due to Cole being unresponsive. Medical staff responded and performed life saving attempts. They performed CPR and administered NARCAN. Cole was taken from the cell on stretcher while staff was still working on him. I have no additional details to add regarding this incident or any other inmates.

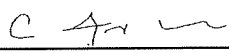

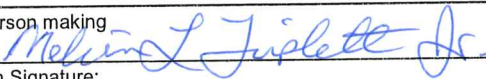

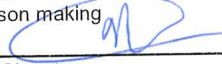

I make the following statement, without fear, threat or promise. I have been advised that any statement(s) made herein which I do not believe to be true, and which statement is intended to mislead a public servant in the performance of his/her official function, is a crime under C.G.S. section 53a-157b and is punishable by law.

I, Qunita Allen (DOB 02/05/1988), have been a Correctional Officer for the last three years. Since graduating from the academy, I have been assigned to Garner Correctional Institute. On July 20, 2024, I was assigned to work the evening shift, which starts at 4pm and ends at midnight. My duties include tours, facility count and overall oversight of the inmates. I was assigned to work Gulf Unit #2 Officer. This unit has 50 cells all together and can house about 96 inmates. Throughout the whole shift I conducted tours of the cells every 15 minutes. Inmate, Cole Tyler, was housed in one of the cells I was responsible for on the 2nd floor. Tyler remained in his cell throughout the duration of my entire shift, except coming out of the cell for chow, which is in the day room at about 5pm. Chow lasts about 20 minutes. I conducted tours every 15 minutes, which consist of illuminating the cell, placing my eyes on each inmate and confirming that they are living and breathing. Every time I conducted a check of Tyler's cell, I was able to confirm that he was alive throughout the evening shift hours. Tyler spent majority of the shift laying on his bunk. I know Tyler is being prescribed Methadone, which he received daily. I did not notice anything suspicious or out of ordinary during my shift.
