On 02/10/2024 at approximately 0239 hours, Bristol Police Officers Jason DaCosta, Evan Mitchell, Jared Yager, and Sgt. Brian Jones began arriving at Bristol Hospital for the report of a female party later identified as Alexandra Standish who was dropped off by a male party, later identified as Brandon Hamel (Bristol Case # 2400005535). Officers were advised enroute that Alexandra was unresponsive and according hospital staff Hamel became aggressive on scene.

Brandon was briefly interviewed in the emergency department's lobby but shortly after voluntarily accompanies Officer Mitchell and Officer DaCosta into a private exam room where the two officers conduct a preliminary interview.

Brandon explained that he, Alexandra, and "his brother" were at Johnny B's Bar in Wolcott. Hamel stated they left the bar and went home. Brandon stated he went into the house to urinate while Alexandra stayed outside to smoke a cigarette in the driveway. Brandon stated after about 5 to 10 minutes she did not come into the house so he went outside and said, "Babe you good?" Brandon stated he saw Alexandra, "literally laying at the end of the driveway." Brandon stated he pulled the car out of the garage, when up to Alexandra and said a couple of times; "Babe you alright?" He said she was snoring. Brandon said he put her in the car and drove to the hospital at about 80 mph. The officers asked Brandon if she was hit by a car where Brandon replied he did not know. Brandon stated no one was with them at the house but his "brother" was with them at the bar. Officer Mitchell asked Brandon if he saw anyone else around to which Brandon replied "No." The interviews were captured on the two officer's Axon Body Cameras which were reviewed by the undersigned. The Bristol Officers also submitted written reports about the incident.
