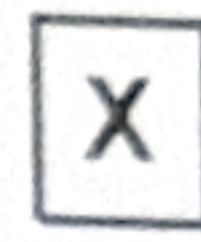

On 02/10/2024 at approximately 0444 hours, Detective Hamel and I interviewed Bristol Hospital Emergency Room Technician Brielle Shepard. Shepard was the only remaining staff member who was still at work at this time; all other staff involved had left at the end of their shift. Shepard stated she had walked out to the emergency department entrance with other staff (at approximately 0227 hours). Shepard stated she saw the boyfriend (B. Hamel) standing in the doorway of the passenger side of the car. Shepard stated she could see Standish on the passenger side floor where you put your feet, cradled up, with her head facing the driver's side. Shepard stated she could see that Standish's lips were blue. Shepard stated B. Hamel was hovering over Standish in the car doorway moving slowly saying multiple times, "Don't look at her chest." Shepard stated she and other staff members kept telling B. Hamel that they got it from here and asked him several times to move but she reported B. Hamel was "putting up a fight." At this point, multiple nurses were outside trying to get B. Hamel to move out of the way. Brandon Hamel was aggressive, mostly verbal, but trying to swing at us. Shepard stated the nurses swatted B. Hamel away from the doorway, Standish was lifted on the stretcher, and brought into the emergency department. I later reviewed the video from the emergency room entrance (Main ED entrance) and at 02:28:06 hours B. Hamel is seen shoving a male nurse with his right hand into the "V" of the doorway as the male nurse is attempting to move past B. Hamel into the car's open doorway. Shepard continually stated how B. Hamel was delaying their treatment of Standish by standing in their way as they were attempting to initiate care. This interview was captured on the Wolcott Police Axon Body Camera System.
