

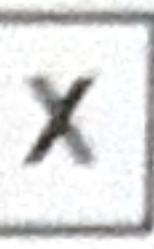

James Sadlowski's second interview ended on 2/11/24, at 10:26 a.m., and he walked outside shortly afterwards. We spoke to James Burrow for a few minutes and then Burrow left the building at 10:43 am. Both men spoke in the parking lot and then entered Burrows vehicle.

At 10:45 a.m., both men returned to the front lobby. We were told by dispatch that James Sadlowski wanted to speak to us again.

I turned on my body camera, which showed Det. Hamel and I walk to the front lobby of the Wolcott Police Department. At 10:55:53 a.m., Burrow said "He wants to tell you something" and he pointed at James Sadlowski. I stayed in the lobby with Burrow and Det. Hamel walked Sadlowski to the interview room. I asked Burrow if he (Sادلowski) wants to come clean. Burrow said they (He and Sadlowski) walked outside and Burrow asked Sadlowski, why did you do that? Sadlowski said it's not good, they have the ring footage camera. Burrow said he asked Sadlowski, so what happened? Sadlowski answered (10:56:14) "I killed her". Burrow said they got in his truck and Sadlowski lit up a cigarette. Burrow said to Sadlowski that if it was an accident he needs to go back inside and tell the truth. I left Burrow in the lobby at 10:57:14 a.m.

At 10:57:50 a.m., I walked into the interview room with Det. Hamel and James Sadlowski (7/3/92). Although Sadlowski walked in voluntarily, and he asked for an attorney at his earlier interview, Det. Hamel read him his Constitutional Rights, which he stated he understood and waived. Sadlowski initialed and signed a rights form. Sadlowski was asked if he wanted a water or anything before we get started and he asked for a cup that he can spit into. I got him a cup and the interview began at 11:00:44 a.m.

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Det. Hamel said to Sadlowski that he came back inside voluntarily and that we are here to listen to what he has to say. Sadlowski said he handed her the jackets and then they got into a little spat over chains that were in the back of his truck. The chains were for pulling items out of the woods, where they are scrapping. Sadlowski said he thought she walked back to the house and he backed up and backed over her. I asked him if it happened like this, why was he so nervous? I asked if he was too intoxicated and what was he thinking? Sadlowski said he backed over her with his back drivers side tire. I asked if it was both tires and he said that he wasn't sure. He said he backed up and thought he popped a curb and he pulled forward. Det. Hamel asked if he backed up and ran over her and then pulled foreword and ran over her again. Sadlowski said I'm not sure, I think I was on top of her when I stopped and then I went forward. I asked Sadlowski if he was arguing with her. He said we were arguing about the chains and shit. I asked if she went behind his truck to try to stop him from leaving. Sadlowski said she wanted him to stay there at the house, because of all of the cops that are around. Sadlowski once again said he started up the truck and thought she walked back to the house. I asked where was Brandon during all of this, he said that he didn't know. Det. Hamel asked, so when you got out of the truck what happened? Sadlowski said that he (Sادلowski) flipped the fuck out. He said at that time, she was still alive. Det. Hamel asked if she was saying anything. He said she was blinking and mumbling here and there. Sadlowski said Brandon came outside and he (Sادلowski) flipped the fuck out, I was saying that I had to call 911, I had to call the cops and I needed to call everybody. Sadlowski said Brandon yelled no just help me get her into the car. Sadlowski said Brandon was cussing her out, because she's sitting there blinking and shit. He's (Brandon) thinking that she's playing games and shit. Det. Hamel asked if Brandon said anything to her. Sadlowski said Brandon said knock your shit off babe, get up. Sadlowski said they then got her up and into the car. He said Brandon pulled the car up and they got her into the passenger seat. When asked if she was still moving, Sadlowski said she was still moving and blinking and talking, not talkin, but mumbling. Sadlowski said after they got her into the car, Brandon said he was going to the hospital and told me (Sادلowski) to take off.

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Sadlowski said he then went back to the hotel (Meriden Inn, Meriden). I asked Sadlowski why Brandon would stick up for him so much, if you just hit his girl. Sadlowski said I don't know, it was an accident, I did it. I asked Sadlowski about how the accident happened again. I asked if when he backed up he went over her with the back tire and the front tire. Sadlowski said the back tire. He said he backed up and he wasn't able to go anywhere, he said his back tire was on her. He said he then pulled forward. He said this is when he jumped out and saw her. Sadlowski said he (Brandon) left and went to the hospital. When asked is he ever spoke to Brandon, Sadlowski said he called me once for about two seconds and Brandon said he was at the hospital. Sadlowski said he asked Brandon if he wanted him to come down and Brandon said no. I asked Sadlowski when he found out that she died. He said when you guys told me, which would have been the day before at Ground Zero Airsoft. Sadlowski said he didn't text or tell anyone what happened.

I asked Sadlowski if he did any drugs that night, he said no I don't do drugs. He said he drinks Jameson and Budwieser. I asked if he was drinking during the day when they were scrapping. He said no, he said he started drinking when they got to the bar at about 11:00 p.m. I asked how much he had to drink and he said four or five beers and a shot with each one.

When asked if she was trying to get into the back of his truck to get the chains out, Sadlowski said I don't know. I asked Sadlowski how did he feel holding that in, that he hit her. He said like shit. He then said that he didn't tell anyone what he did. When asked if his truck would have any damage, he said no, he thought only the tire hit her. Det. Hamel asked if she fell down behind his truck or did he bump her, Sadlowski said he wasn't sure. He said he didn't feel or hear a bump. Sadlowski said that he hasn't spoken to Brandon since this happened.

The interview ended at 11:23:06 a.m. We then walked Sadlowski out to the front parking lot, where Burrow was waiting for him.

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
