

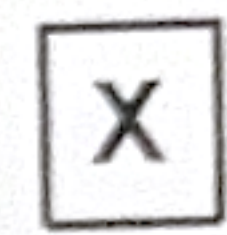

On 2/11/24, at about 9:00 a.m., I (Det. Jackson) spoke on the phone to James Burrow (7/11/65, cell [REDACTED]). Burrow said Sadlowski was lying yesterday about how long he was at Allie and Brandon's house. Burrow told me that he has screen shots on his phone proving this. He said he'll show me when he brings Sadlowski to the police department. Burrow said Sadlowski is on his way to his house (1 [REDACTED]). He said Sadlowski won't drive to the police department, because his (Sادلowski's) truck is unregistered.

On 2/11/24, at 10:10 a.m., James Sadlowski (7/3/92) came to the Wolcott Police Department to give a statement about what happened during the night of 2/10/24. Sadlowski was with James Burrow. At 10:14 a.m., Det. Hamel and I walked into the front lobby. Detective Hamel walked Sadlowski to the interview room and I stayed in the lobby to speak to Burrow.

Burrow pulled out his phone and showed me screenshots of an app called Life 360, which tracks location information. James received the screen shots from Natalie Burke (11/23/92 - [REDACTED]), who is Sadlowski's ex-girlfriend and friends with all of them. He explained on Life 360, solitude is always the starting location.

Burrow said that on the night of the incident, Sadlowski was at Brandon and Allie's house from 1:23 a.m. to 2:09 a.m. and in Meriden from 2:27 a.m., to 7:06 a.m. Burrow said Brandon was at the house from 1:41 a.m., until 2:10 a.m, when he drove to Bristol Hospital. Brandon hit the top speed of 98 miles an hour on the way to the hospital. Burrow said there was too much of a time span in there and he believed something more happened at the house. Burrow said that Sadlowski's truck is parked at his (Burrow's) home at [REDACTED]. Burrow sent the screenshots to me. They will be put into the case file.

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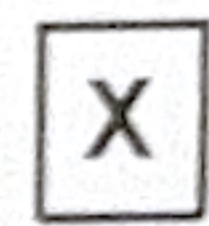
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Det. Hamel read James Sadlowski his Constitutional Rights, which he stated he understood and waived. He signed and initialed the rights card. The interview started at 10:21 a.m.

Det. Hamel asked Sadlowski to explain again what happened. Sadlowski said they were all at the site scrapping yesterday and they were there until about 10 or 11:00 p.m. He said they all went to the bar and had a few drinks. He said they went back to the house and Allie came over to the truck, grabbed the jackets and he took off. I asked Sadlowski if he was only there for three minutes like he told us yesterday. Sadlowski said they all have GPS in their phones and he looked and he was actually there for 20 minutes. When asked about the big difference from what he told us yesterday, when he said he was there for 3 minutes and now it was 20 minutes, Sadlowski said - sorry I was cocked. Sadlowski continued with the same story, he already told us. Det. Hamel asked Sadlowski if at any point did he get out of his truck while at the house. Sadlowski blinked numerous times, rubbed his head and said - I don't think so, I got out to hand her the jackets, maybe. Sadlowski continued with saying that they were arguing and they went into the house. Det. Hamel told Sadlowski that the cameras were working at the house and that we know that something happened while you (Sادلowski) were there. Sadlowski said "I'd like an attorney please" The interview then ended at 10:26 a.m. We explained to Sadlowski that we are towing his tuck and talking his cell phone as evidence. Sadlowski put his cell phone on the table. We then walked him out.

I went to the front lobby and asked Burrow to come inside to the interview room. I walked out to the front parking lot and asked Sadowski for his truck key so we could tow his truck.

In the interview room, Burrow said on the way to the police department he told him (Sادلowski) to just tell the truth. I asked Burrow if Sadlowski does drugs at all. Burrow said he (Sادلowski) doesn't do drugs. He's known Sadlowski for 10 years, and only knows him to drink.

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His favorite drink is Jameson, straight up. Burrow said Sadlowski will play that he doesn't remember things, because of an old TBI, but if he (Burrow) owed Sadlowski forty bucks, he'd (Sادلowski) remember that for two years.

We were told by Brandon Hamel and James Burrow that Sadlowski has a nervous condition and blinks uncontrollably when he's lying. The day before, Sadlowski was wearing sunglasses and we could'nt see any blinking.

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
