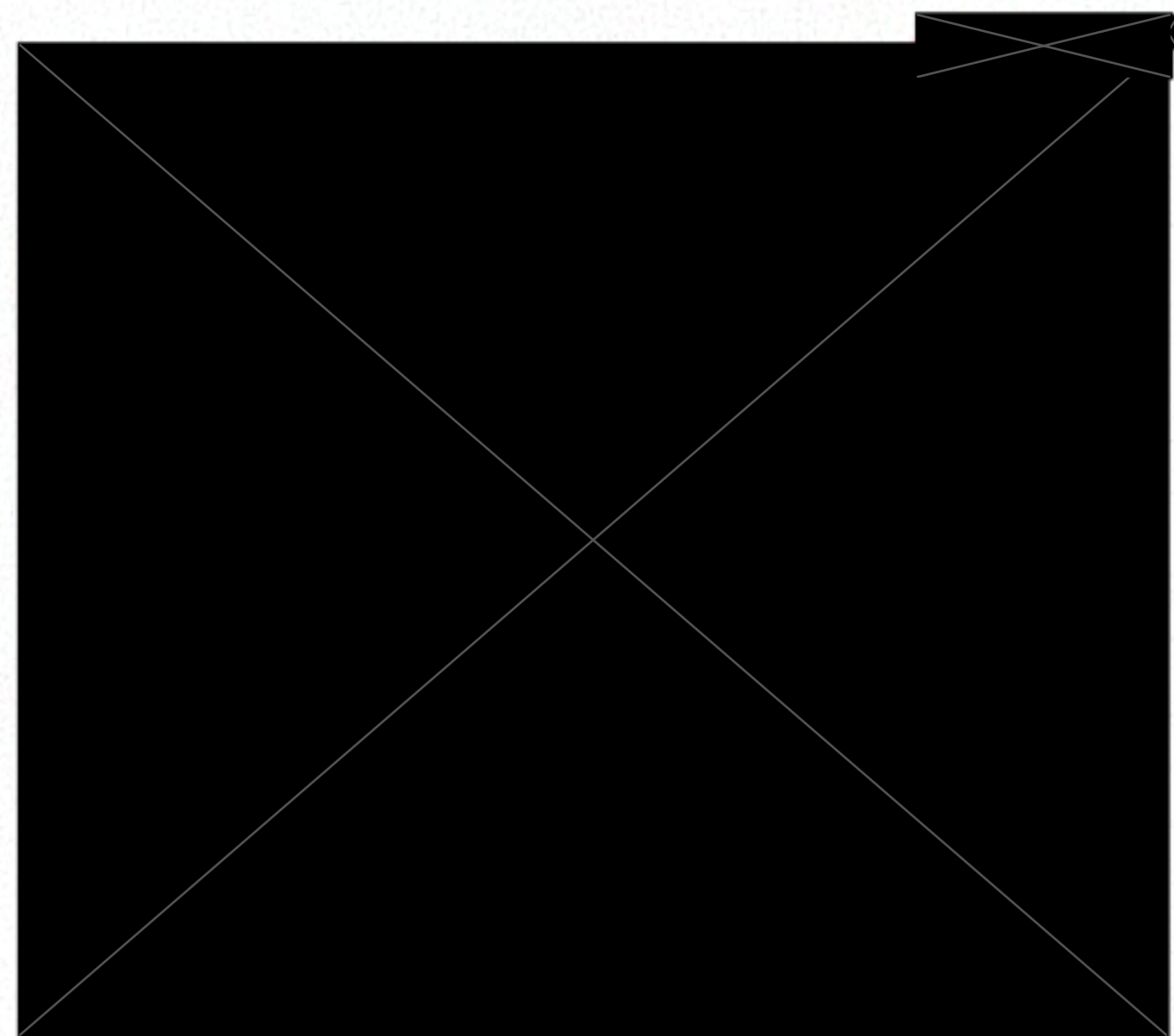

Hello Judge Klatt and attorney Platt,

I just wanted to Follow up with a status on then above referenced case.

During my meeting with attorney Platt to discuss the issue of Manuel Santiago's sentence yesterday, we discussed a couple of options to resolve the issue. One of the possible resolutions was to see if there was a way to move the charges from Docket UWY-CR24-0508443-T to either docket UWY-CR22-0500669-T or UWY-CR22-0500670-T both of which have the same arrest date. After our meeting, I spoke with the clerk's office and confirmed that this could be accomplished by filing a motion to re-open the judgement, having the please vacated on UWY-CR24-0508443-T, and having Mr. Santiago enter pleas on Docket UWY-CR22-0500669-T or UWY-CR22-0500670-T (as I believe was our original intention).

With your attorney Platt's agreement⁵, I spoke to Judge Klatt and proposed this possible resolution. It's my understanding, however, that Judge Klatt would prefer that this be handled through a Sentence Modification. I have already filed a written motion on August 12, 2025 which was forwarded to the State's Attorney's office, the Court, as well as victim's advocate. I will also file the Application to Modify /Change Sentence and Order (JD-CR-68) and the Notice of Application filed seeking, (JD-VS-3).

I believe Attorney Klatt was concerned that any modification to Mr. Santiago's sentence would contrast with what she conveyed to the claimants when she explained the plea deal to them. However, I hope that we can all agree that a modification of his sentence actually effectuates what was originally agreed upon which was a split sentence with 4 years to serve. Not modifying the sentence, on the other hand, would result in Mr. Santiago serving a period of incarceration of an additional 20 months that what was agreed upon.

I am open to hearing any other ideas on the best was to handle this and welcome your thoughts on this matter. Otherwise, I will be filing the application and notice by tomorrow. I will be in the office for the rest of the day today and all day tomorrow and can make time to speak on this further if needed.
