**Re: Investigation into the Homicide of Shane DeJongh, October 5-6, 2023**

Dear Chief Jortner,

Please be advised that BBB Attorneys, LLC represents Zoey DeJongh Quinn and Robyn Van Ekelenburg, respectively the daughter and sister of the late Shane DeJongh. Ms. Van Ekelenburg is also the administrator of the Estate of Mr. DeJongh.

We sent you a letter dated February 19, 2026. We heard no response from you. We sent a second letter dated March 26, 2026. We heard no response.

The facts of this case require serious investigation. The autopsy declared Mr. DeJongh's broken hyoid bone and crushed larynx the result of homicide. Police found Mr. DeJongh's corpse upstairs in bed, yet it would have been impossible for him to climb a flight of stairs with those injuries.

To say Shane's family feels frustrated with law enforcement in this case is an understatement. We beg of you to communicate with us.
